

<sup>1</sup> According to the Archdiocesan UPR Uniform Regulations, Article 18, §1, *steward in good standing is the one who practices all the religious and moral duties and must be: eighteen years of age or over; be current in his or her stewardship and other financial obligations to the Parish, abide by all the regulations stated in the Archdiocesan Bylaws; and cooperate in every way towards the welfare and well-being of the Parish. In addition, according to the Annunciation Greek Orthodox Cathedral local bylaws Article 3, §3.4, a parishioner who has fulfill his or her stewardship commitment - A parishioner's stewardship commitment in any year is the financial obligation indicated on the stewardship Commitment Card for such year - for the prior year and has completed a Stewardship Commitment Card for the current calendar year shall be eligible to vote at the Spring Parish Assembly and any Special Parish Assembly. A parishioner who has fulfilled his or her stewardship commitment for the prior year, has completed a Stewardship Commitment Card for the current year, and has paid one-half (1/2) of his or her current year stewardship commitment shall be eligible to vote at the Fall Parish General Assembly*
