# **Proportionate Giving**

The Old Testament laid down the standard of the tithe or 10% of one's income. This provides us with the principle that giving should be in proportion with our income. Stewardship is returning to God a fair proportion of the resources He has given to us. Every person 18 years of age or older and married couples, should be Stewards of the Community, offering their time, talent and treasure to the Church.

# Monthly Contributions

In an effort to assist our Parishioners in determining their contribution, we suggest that when making your pledge you consider what you can afford monthly, rather than annually. It is hoped that a majority of our Parishioners will challenge themselves this year to reach the <u>\$60 per month</u> pledge.

This type of contribution will enable us to reach our goal of sustaining the annual expenses of the Church by Stewardship income alone.

#### **CHRIST MULTIPLIES OUR GIFTS**




